

ZONE 7 SHOW - CONFERENCE CALL
JULY 29, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM, by the Chairperson, Marjorie Moser. Joining the Conference Call were: Marjorie Moser (Chairperson), Dorothy Quirk (Secretary), Jane Munn (Treasurer), Karen Roy (New England PHC), Ashley DiMeo (Garden State PHC), Judy Moyer (Garden State PHC), Kathy Reinert (Empire State PHC), Jill Pacelli (Empire State PHC), Allison Umberger (Virginia PHC).

MINUTES: Motion was made (Pacelli/Munn) and passed to accept the Minutes from the May 6, 2019, meeting as they were printed.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Jane Munn reported a balance on hand of \$12,127 (from sponsorships). She has paid our show insurance bill of \$275. Motion was made (Quirk/Pacelli) and passed to accept the report as given.

LEADLINE: It had previously been suggested that the leadline ribbons be "multi-color". However, they will be blue.

JACKPOT CLASSES: The Jackpot Class ribbons will be "rainbow" color. The winner will receive a "Neck Ribbon".

ZONE POWER CORDS: Dorothy Quirk reported that we still have several heavy-duty power cords which were used to power the additional stall tent from a previous Zone show. Since we will not need them in the future, it was suggested that we sell them for half price (using the current pricing). Dorothy said that she has someone who will purchase them. Motion was made (Quirk/Moyer) that we sell the power cords.

PATTERNS: Judy reported that she has a good majority of the patterns already printed and will have the balance ready for the show.

SWEATSHIRT/JACKET SALE: Kathy Reinert reported that there were 20 hoodies and one jacket ordered - giving us a profit of \$413. Additional orders will be taken by the Show Secretaries at the show.

DREAM PARK ANNEX STALLS: Motion made (Moyer/Munn) and passed that we not utilize these stalls.

FUTURE DREAM PARK BARN RENOVATIONS: Marjorie reported that both Barn A and Barn B will have their roofs "raised" for the 2020 show season which will allow for better ventilation.

SCRIBE DISCUSSION: To be discussed at our November Planning Meeting - APHA wants shows to have scribes for all judges for all events. The question is - how will we handle the expense of paying these scribes for so many classes in the future. Should we add a "scribe fee" to our exhibitors' bills? If we pay the scribes, how much will we pay them? Ashley is getting scribes for our Zone Show this year, It was suggested that we may be able to get 4-H members, etc. to scribe for us since they can use it as their school / Club "Community Service" time. We have always paid our scribes in the past.

JUDGES: Karen Roy reported that all of the judges have signed their contracts and have been taken care of.

BOTTLED WATER / JUDGES' SNACKS: Jane Munn will purchase these items. We will also be providing "free" water for the exhibitors.

COMPLIMENTARY BREAKFAST: Carli Progin confirmed that "Breakfast Coupons" will be available for Saturday morning.

AWARDS:

- There will be one "Circuit Medallion" in each class. Toby will calculate the "High Point" exhibitor using a composite from the six judges. These will only be awarded in classes of three or more horses.
- The medallion winner in the "rail" classes will complete a "Victory Lap" after they receive their medallion.
- Show "High Point" Awards: Youth Walk-Trot will receive a vest and the other Divisions will receive a Zone buckle.
- Grand and Reserve High Points (at the end of the show): will receive a vest or stall bag.
- Third through Fifth Awards: Each "Division" placing will also receive an award.
- Halter High Points: Carla Perry will sponsor these.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 PM.
